

EATING DISORDER PLAN

Your EDP will expire 12-months from the date that the original plan was created.

PSYCHOLOGIST

40 MEDICARE REBATES
PER 12-MONTHS PERIOD

STEP ONE

Attend appointment with your GP, Paediatrician, or Psychiatrist to determine if you are eligible for an Eating Disorder Plan (EDP).

If you meet the eligibility criteria, a GP, Psychiatrist, Paediatrician will provide you with an EDP.

STEP TWO

Commence an **initial 10 session** course of treatment with psychologist. **(sessions 1-10)**

STEP THREE

When you have completed 10 sessions, return to your GP for the first review. If you meet eligibility criteria you will be granted a further 10 sessions. **(sessions 11-20)**

STEP FOUR

Attend a paediatrician or psychiatrist appointment prior to your 20th session. If you are eligible to access further sessions, they will provide a review to your GP. You will then need to return to your GP to obtain a second EDP review. **(sessions 21-30).**

STEP FIVE

When you have completed 30 sessions, you will need to return to your GP for a third (final) review. If you are eligible you will be granted another 10 sessions. **(sessions 31-40)**

STEP SIX

When you have completed 40 sessions you will be unable to obtain another EDP until 12 months after the start date of the plan.

STEP ONE

Attend appointment with your GP, Paediatrician, or Psychiatrist to determine if you are eligible for an Eating Disorder Plan (EDP).

STEP TWO

Commence course of 20 eating disorder treatment sessions with dietitian. **(sessions 1-20)**

STEP SIX

When you have completed 20 sessions you will be unable to obtain another EDP until 12 months after the start date of the plan.
